**Trail:** You may walk the course before the show. All trail classes will be Walk halt or Walk trot. The course will be held on the track. The footing will be the race track screenings material. The trail course will be open at the beginning of the show and will close at the end of the lunch break. Trail will be judged by a second judge.

**Points System:** 1<sup>st</sup> place 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> place 5 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> place 4 points, 4<sup>th</sup> place 3 points 5<sup>th</sup> place 2 points, 6<sup>th</sup> place. For those riders not placing in the top 6, one point will be awarded for participation. Six ribbons per class.

**RULES and High Point Divisions:** Each division riders can accumulate points as specified in the division descriptions below. Riders can earn points in only one division and must be identified before the start of the show. *Therapeutic riders* are welcome in the lead line and walk halt divisions. Age is not a limiting factor for the therapeutic rider showing in the Lead line and Walk-Halt divisions. Please contact the show committee before registration for any special accommodations.

**Lead Line division:** Riders can show in the appropriate halter classes and classes # 7, #14 and Trail class A. Class #14 will be judged and awards given to all. This division is limited to 8 year old and under. Therapeutic riders are welcome in this division. Costume class is open to all divisions. Lead line riders must be 8 years or under and may only show in youth showmanship and walk-halt.

**Walk-Halt division** Riders can show the appropriate halter class and classes # 7, #15, #16, #23 and Trail class B. This division is limited to ages 9 years old and under. Therapeutic riders are welcome in this division.

**Pee Wee division** Riders can show in the appropriate halter class and classes #7, #17, #18, #25, #26 and Trail class C for points. This division is limited to 12 year olds and under. Riders in this division are eligible to cross enter other classes for the day. Pee Wee classes are WALK – TROT.

**Walk trot 13 - 18 division** Riders can show in the appropriate halter class and classes #8, #19, #20, #27 and Trail class D for points. This division is limited to rider ages 13 to 18.

**Walk trot Adult** Riders can show in the appropriate halter class and classes #9, #21, #22, #28 and Trail class E for points. This division is limited to anyone over 18 year olds.

**Hunter over Fences division:** Riders in this division are of any age. For points in this division, riders can show in the appropriate halter classes and classes #11, #12 and #13. Riders in this division may show in other divisions

**Arabian/Half-Arabian division:** Riders/handlers in this division are of any age. For points in this division, riders/handlers can show in classes #1, #34, and 42.

**Youth English division:** Riders in this division are 18 years and under. Riders can show in the appropriate halter classes and classes #8, #30, #31, #32, #40, and Trail class F for points.

**Youth Western division:** Riders in this division are 18 years and under. Riders can show in the show the appropriate halter classes and classes #8, #39, #44, #45, #48 and Trail class F for points.

**Adult division:** Riders in this division are over 18 years old. Riders can show in the show the appropriate halter class and classes #9, #29, #43, #46, #52 and Trail class G for points.

**Rusty Riders division:** Riders in this division are over 35 and don't regularly show. Riders of any seat are welcome in this division. Riders can show in the appropriate halter class and classes #9, #47, #49, #51, #53, and Trail class E for points.

#### GENERAL RULES

1. All Entry Fees: \$5.00 Check made payable to NCPAHA
2. Office/Grounds Fee\* is \$5.00\*Office/Grounds fee assessed to keep individual class costs from increasing.
3. Stall fee: Horse Stall \$10 Tack Stall \$5.00
4. Costume class is open to all divisions.
5. Health requirement: All animals exhibited at the show must be in good health and condition. Any animal showing signs of illness, lameness or poor condition will be asked to leave the grounds by the show committee. All equine on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins. Please present at the show office. ***Negative Coggins required show at Office***
6. Please make entries at least two (2) classes prior to the class you wish to enter. Please use the Scratch / Add form.
7. Please notify the secretary's stand of any needed tack changes; tack changes will be limited to 3 minutes and must be for back to back classes. In order to keep the show moving, the show committee will award only two tack changes to a competitor. Tack changes need to take place at the gate. Please plan accordingly.
8. The show will run with a 2 minute gate. This means the gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring. This WILL BE enforced.
9. **STALLS:** We have a limited number, most of which are used by our youth who attend the Saturday clinic. We are not permitted to use all the stalls on the grounds. Please do not use a stall without checking with the show office regarding availability and price. **PLEASE DO NOT CALL TO RESERVE STALLS. All bedding and debris must be removed from the stalls upon the completion of the show.**
10. Judge's decision shall be final!
11. Safe riding attire is expected – i.e. boots/shoes with heels – and protective head gear **MUST** be worn over jumps at all times.
12. Camping- A limited number of electrical hook up are available. Please contact Amy for reservation. \$25 camping fee
13. Neither the PA Arabian Horse Assn NC District nor the Lycoming County Fair Association shall be responsible for any injuries to horses or exhibitors or for any lost or stolen equipment.
14. All returned check will be charged an additional \$30 fee.
