Open Show High Point Division Awards (13)

Therapeutic, Hunter over Fences, Hunter on the Flat, Sport Horse, Miniature Horse, Ranch Horse, Lead Line, Pee Wee (W-T), Youth Hunter, Youth Western, Adult, Masters/Rusty Rider (W-T), Open.

See division descriptions on next page.

RULES and High Point Divisions: Each horse rider combination can accumulate points in one or more divisions. See descriptions below. Riders can earn points in one Pleasure division, Hunter over Fences division, Hunter on the Flat division as well as the Open division. The office must be notified before the start of the show of your division choices.

Points System: 1st place 6 points, 2nd place 5 points, 3rd place 4 points, 4th place 3 points, 5th place 2 points, 6th place 1 point. Six ribbons per class.

Therapeutic Riders Division: Age is not a limiting factor for the therapeutic rider Minimum & Maximum assistance will compete together in this division. Classes 18, 19, 50, 55, 63. *No halter class for this division.*

Hunter Over Fences Division: Riders in this division are of any age. Classes 1, 2, 3, 4. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Hunter on the Flat Division: Riders in this division are of any age. Classes 23, 24, 25. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Sport Horse Division: Riders any age can show in the appropriate halter class and classes 32, 60. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Miniature Horse Division: Riders any age can show in classes 6, 52, 57, 58, 59

Ranch Horse Division: Riders in this division are of any age. For points in this division, riders can show in the classes 65, 66, 67, 68. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Pleasure Division

Lead Line Division: Riders age 8 & under can show in classes and classes 11, 20, 21, 22 51, 56, 64 *Lead line riders may not cross into other divisions. No halter class for this division.*

Pee Wee Division: Riders 12 and under can show in the appropriate halter class and classes 11, 26, 27, 28, 48, 53, 61 Pee Wee classes are WALK/TROT. *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

Youth Hunter Division: Riders in this division are 18 years and under. Riders can show in the appropriate halter classes and classes. 12, 29, 30, 31, 48, 53, 61

Youth Western Division: Riders in this division are 18 years and under. Riders can show in the show the appropriate halter classes and classes 12, 38, 39, 40, 48, 53, 61

Adult Division: Riders in this division are over 18 years old. Riders can show in the show the appropriate halter class and classes 13, 41, 42, 43, 49, 54, 62.

Master/ Rusty Riders Division: Riders age 35 and over that don't regularly show. Riders of any seat are welcome in this division. Riders can show in the appropriate halter class and classes 13, 35, 36, 37, 49, 54, 62

Open Division: Riders in this division are of any age. For points in this division, riders can show in the appropriate halter classes and classes 11 or 12 or 13, 14, 15, 16 or 17, 34, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 53, 54, 61, 62, *Riders in this division may show in other divisions.*

GENERAL RULES

1. Regular and champion Class Entry Fees: \$5.00 Jackpot class fee is \$10 per class. (50% Pay back to the top 3 places)
2. Check made payable to NC-PAHA Any returned check will be charged an additional \$30 fee.
3. Office/Grounds Fee* is \$5.00*Office/Grounds fee assessed to keep individual class costs from increasing.
4. Stall fee: Horse Stall \$10 Tack Stall \$10.00
5. **Health requirement:** All animals exhibited at the show must be in good health and condition. Any animal showing signs of illness, lameness or poor condition will be asked to leave the grounds by the show committee. All equine on the grounds must have a current negative Coggins. Please present at the show office. ***Negative Coggins required please show at Office upon arrival.***
6. Please make entries at least two (2) classes prior to the class you wish to enter. Please use the Scratch / Add form.
7. Please notify the secretary's stand of any needed tack changes; tack changes will be limited to 3 minutes and must be for back to back classes. In order to keep the show moving, the show committee will award only two tack changes to a competitor. Tack changes need to take place at the gate. Please plan accordingly.
8. The show will run with a 2 minute gate. This means the gate will close 2 minutes after the first horse enters the ring.
9. **STALLS:** We have a limited number, most of which are used by our youth who attend the Saturday clinic. We are not permitted to use all the stalls on the grounds. Please do not use a stall without checking with the show office regarding availability and price. **All bedding and debris must be removed from the stalls upon the completion of the show.**
10. Judge's decision shall be final!
11. Safe riding attire is expected – i.e. boots/shoes with heels – and protective head gear **MUST** be worn over jumps at all times.
12. Camping- A limited number of electrical hook ups are available. Please contact Amy for reservation. \$25 camping fee. 570-660-5085
13. Neither the PA Arabian Horse Assn NC District nor the Lycoming County Fair Association shall be responsible for any injuries to horses or exhibitors or for any lost or stolen equipment.
