- Current USEF Rules Will Be Followed.
- English classes open to Hunter, Dressage or Saddle seat Styles of riding.
- Ribbons awarded for 1st-6th places. TIP Classes require a copy of your TIP Number Card to enter TIP classes. TIP classes receive TIP prizes & ribbons.
- Horses/rider combos entered in walk-trot may not show in any class that requires a canter, except Intro C & all Ranch Horse Classes.
- Management reserves the right to cancel, combine or split classes as necessary.
- Current USEF & USDF & Western Dressage tests will be used.
- Ranch Classes are Approved by East Coast Ranch Riding Association.
- Judge's decision is final.
- Show management will settle all disputes.
- Halter & Showmanship Championships are free to the 1st & 2nd place horses in each qualifying class only.
- Performance championships are \$15 and must be entered. Horses shown in any qualifying class are eligible for championships, regardless of placing or not.

Coming from the North or South, get to 222 and get off the Denver/ PA Turnpike exit. Head towards 272. At the light, go left (south) onto 272. Go 1.7 miles, then turn right onto W. Church Street. Go 2.5 miles (along the way Church Street becomes Main St, then Steinmetz Rd). Go up a hill, and as you start down the hill, Kline Road is on your right. Go right onto Kline Road. Grounds are less than ¼ mile up on the left.
